Dear Utah Job's Daughters and Bethel Guardian Councils:

All eligible Utah Job's Daughters who are seeking academic or vocational education beyond high school are encouraged to apply for 2008 Job's Daughter scholarships.

Eligible members include young women who are active in the Order, unmarried and under the age of 25. Scholarships are to be used in the fiscal year in which they are awarded unless permission is granted for an extension. Unused awards are returned to the scholarship fund for future scholarships.

These monetary awards are made possible by funds raised by two-thirds projects in each Bethel and through fundraising activities in Grand Bethel. The amount of scholarships given is dependent on the amount of money in the fund.

Applications must be submitted on the attached form approved by the Grand Guardian Council. Electronic copies are available from your Bethel Guardian or Bethel Guardian Secretary, the Grand Secretary or on the Utah Job's Daughters Web site, www.utahjobie.org.

Please complete these forms accurately, completely and legibly. Information that is missing or cannot be read or traced to the appropriate sections may cause your application to be disqualified! Also, remember to include two recent letters of recommendation (from non-relatives) and a current academic transcript with your application.

All applications and accompanying materials must be returned to me and postmarked no later than May 10, 2008. Applications postmarked or hand delivered to me after the May 10, 2008 deadline will not be considered. Scholarship winners will be announced during Grand Session in June 2008.
