Miss Utah Job's Daughter Pageant

Dear Utah Job's Daughters,

It is time to start thinking about the Miss Utah Job's Daughter Pageant! This year we are encouraging ALL eligible Daughters to try out. It is a fun growing experience and you meet great people!

The all-in-one day pageant and competition will be held on Saturday, September 15th, 2018 beginning at 8:30 A.M. We will begin the pageant with the usual preliminary competition, which includes a written test, personal interview, a ritual recitation, extemporaneous speaking and robe judging. The contestants will then have lunch together with our current Misses, Grand Bethel Honored Queen and Grand Guardians. After a break for a few hours in the afternoon, we will have the banquet, final pageant and crowning of the 2018-2019 Miss Utah Job's Daughter and Miss Utah Congeniality.

Eligibility

Any Job's Daughter, in good standing in her Bethel, who has passed proficiency, who is not yet twenty (20) years old as of the Utah Pageant, September 15th, 2018 and who will be at least sixteen (16) years old by the 2019 Miss International Pageant to be held in Overland Park, Kansas.

Written Test

The written test will cover Bylaws, the Ritual (Revised 2011) and Book of Ceremonies. We suggest that you study the following:

Bylaws: Supreme, Grand and Bethel Constitution and Bylaws, Landmarks, Miss IJD Pageant and the Utah R&R including the MUJD Pageant.
Ritual (Revised 2011): Cover-to-Cover
Book of Ceremonies and Job's Daughters Music Ritual

Please note: the test is **not** limited to items listed above.

The JDI Knowledge Course available from the Supreme Office may be helpful in studying for the test. You can contact the Supreme Office at (402) 592-7987.

Ritual Recitation

Contestants this year will need to learn both Fourth and Fifth Messenger parts. Contestants will draw from a hat the part they will perform. Contestants will need to recite the Station and Duties (charge) as well as the Initiation part including any instructions to the Guide and Marshal.

Entry Forms and Fee

Entry forms must be filled out with accompanying information, entry fee and postmarked (or hand delivered) by Sunday, August 19th, 2018. Contestants can hand deliver their forms to Nicole Bronson at the Field Day to be held on August 19th, 2018. The entry fee for this year's competition will be \$20.00. All competitors will enjoy a complimentary contestant lunch, banquet dinner ticket and a pageant T-shirt. Check for entry fees should be made payable to the Grand Guardian Council. Please note financial assistance is available if the registration fee is an issue.

Personal Health Form

All Daughters who are participating in the Miss Utah Job's Daughter Pageant must submit an original copy of a Job's Daughters International Personal Health Form. This form is needed incase an emergency were to arise at the pageant sleepover or any events that may occur during the course of the year if selected as Miss Utah Job's Daughter or Miss Utah Congeniality. Health forms will be held by the official chaperones of the newly crowned misses for the course of their year in office. Health forms must be submitted by the date of the pageant sleepover for Daughters to spend the night without their parent's accompaniment.

Mark your calendar for the Pageant Contestant Sleepover on August 25th, 2017 at 5:30 P.M. (Spirit Ambassadors are to arrive at 6:30 giving you an hour of undivided attention!) at the Bountiful Masonic Temple.
