Dear Utah Job's Daughters and Bethel Guardian Councils:

As Grand Session/Rally 2019 approaches, it is time to give thought to helping our Daughters who may be furthering their education. All eligible Utah Job's Daughters who are seeking academic or vocational education beyond high school are encouraged to apply for the 2019 Utah Job's Daughters scholarships. These scholarships are designed to assist young women who will be attending college, university or trade/technology school.

Eligible members are young women who are currently active in the Order, unmarried and under the age of 25. (**NOTE:** Young women, who are Majority Members of the Order and are serving on the Council of a Bethel, unmarried, and under the age of 25, are also eligible to apply). Scholarships are to be used in the fiscal year in which they are awarded unless permission is granted for an extension – on a case-by-case basis – by the Board of Trustees. Unused awards are returned to the scholarship fund for future scholarships.

The total amount of scholarships awarded is dependent on the amount of money in the scholarship fund. The fund consists of money raised by two-thirds projects in each Bethel, the Grand Bethel's Senior Princess fundraising project, and any donations made from the Past Grand Guardians, or special memorial funds.

This year the Board of Trustees have redesigned the scholarship application. It is more stream lined, has a fillable form on the website that can be saved and added to in the future. Electronic copies are available from the Grand Secretary, myself or the Utah Job's Daughters' website at www.utahjobie.org. Applications must be submitted on this new form which has been approved by the Grand Guardian Council. Please examine the forms carefully and contact me if you have concerns.

If you chose not to use the fillable form, all forms submitted **MUST BE TYPED**. *Information that is missing, illegible or which cannot be traced to the appropriate section of the forms (as in the case of continuation pages) may cause your application to be disqualified. If you should choose to have your school mail your Official Transcripts to the chairperson, it is your responsibility to follow through and make sure they arrive.* Further, please remember to include or follow through with making sure your one letter of recommendation (from a non-relative) is signed and dated. Preference will be given to Daughters who are pursuing their first degree or technical certificate.

All applications and accompanying materials **MUST** be returned to me (postmarked or hand-delivered) no later than **Saturday, May 11, 2019**. Applications postmarked or hand delivered after the May 11th deadline **WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED**. Scholarships winners will be announced during the Annual Session in June 2019.
